

Analysis of Parish Share formula 40 -60% Stipendiary Element

At the Synod at the start of 2010 it was decided that Reading Deanery should continue with a Parish Share formula based on a % of Stipendiary clergy cost with the balance allotted according to electoral roll. The final decision was delayed until the Synod to be held 4th November, after members have been given an analysis of the effect of changing the % Stipendiary element between the current 40% up to 60%.

Analysis of Parish Share formula

40 -60% Stipendiary Element

A graph for each benefice is given below.

The Deanery share is set by the Diocese according with the nominal deanery “wealth” calculated using the Deanery electoral roll and the income within the Deanery given in 2002 census. Each graph shows the element of the Deanery share (diocese calculation) based on the electoral roll. Also shown is the actual cost of ministry for each benefice.

Analysis of Parish Share formula

40 -60% Stipendiary Element

You will see that a Benefice with two stipendiary priests and an electoral roll of 290

OR with one stipendiary priest and an electoral role of 145 will see little difference as the % stipendiary element of the Deanery formula changes. The more a Benefice diverges from these electoral roll figures the larger the change in Parish share..
